Housing Renewal

Housing Renewal for Summer 2025 and Fall/Spring 2025–26 **begins the week of April 14**. Full details will be shared during your RA floor meetings the week of March 24, and posted on the Housing website.

Key Points:

- Summer housing is limited to students taking on-ground classes. Be prepared to move twice (summer and fall).
- Room selection is based on seniority. Donley Hall is reserved for juniors and seniors.
- Accommodation requests must be approved by April 9 through the Office of Student Access.
- Co-ed housing is no longer permitted—plan your roommate accordingly.
